RULES & IMPORTANT INFO



CONTESTANT INFO

- 1. All Children, parents, carers & staff at KW school are eligible to enter the KW GBBO fundraiser competition.
- 2. Items prepared for the competition must involve the use of an oven.
- 3. Items can be sweet (unless in bread & buns category) or savoury & <u>must</u> be nut free.
- 4. All items must be submitted with a full list of ingredients & have the name and school year of child. For parents, your name, name of your child and the year they're in.
- 5. Submissions will be judged in the following categories : Early Years, KS1, KS2 and Adults.
- 6. The bakes in all categories will be judged by special guest Chigs (2021 GBBO finalist & 2023 GBBO New Years special edition).
- 7. Entries will be judged on their taste, texture, overall presentation, and creativity.

CATEGORIES

- **1. Breads & Buns** Any savoury breads or buns. Extra points if there is a free from theme (e.g., sugar-free, gluten-free, dairy-free, yeast-free, vegan, organic, etc.)
- **2. KW Themed Cake** cake representing Kensington Wade eg Kensington Wade colours, East meets West, Kensington Wade logo.
- **3.** Cup Cakes & Tray Bakes (cupcakes, doughnuts, Flap Jacks, basically mini sweet treats of sorts, there needs to be 6 in total)
- **4. Eastern Sweet Treats** Any oriental sweet bakes. Either 1 large bake (e.g., pandan cake, or 6 mini bakes (e.g., 6 moon cakes)
- Early Years Best decorated & best tasting). Key
 Stage 1 Best decorated & best tasting. Key Stage
 2 Best decorate & best tasting. Adults Best mums
 & best dads.
